Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) and Emergency First Response Secondary Care (First Aid) as presented in the Emergency First Response Instructor Guide, 2002 are considered to meet the First Aider Level One requirement as recommended in *Safety-Wise* for the 24 month period following successful completion of the course.

Notification of this finding will go out to councils this summer and will be in the 9th printing of *Safety-Wise* and newer editions.

It may take a while for the information to permeate all our membership as council timelines may not match with the Girl Scouts of the USA release dates. Please feel free to use this e-mail to support your collaborations with individual councils.
