

Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981

Certificate of Approval First-Aid training and qualifications

- In pursuance of Regulation 3(2) of the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981, The Health and Safety Executive hereby approves for five years after the date of this certificate:
- a) the training given in first aid

by

(hereafter known as the organisation)

At suitable premises in a course which complies with the provision set out in Schedules 1 and 3 of this Certificate and which leads to a certificate in first aid;

and

the training in first aid given by the said organisation in a course which complies with the provisions set out in Schedules 2 and 3 to this b) Certificate and which leads to the award of a certificate in first aid or to an endorsement on a certificate in first aid already held.

In either case following training approved by the Health and Safety Executive for the purposes of the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981.

- 2 The qualification awarded in first aid, by the organisation approved by HSE under this Certificate.
- a) is valid for three years,
- b) is evidenced either by a certificate in first aid awarded by the said organisation or by an endorsement on a certificate in first aid already held, following training approved by the Health and Safety Executive for the purpose of the said Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981; and is gained following an assessment which complies with the provisions set out in Schedule 4 to this Certificate.

The approvals given in paragraphs 1 a) and b) of this Certificate of Approval relate to any case where standard training in first aid and a suitable qualification in first aid are sufficient for a suitable person for the purposes of Regulation 3 (2) of the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981.

The qualification mentioned in paragraph 2 b) must be obtained not more than three years after a qualification in first aid which itself was evidenced by a certificate in first aid or an endorsement on a certificate in first aid following training in first aid approved by the Health and Safety Executive for the purposes of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981.

3. This Certificate of Approval is also subject to the provisions of Schedule 5 to the Certificate.
