First Aid at Work Programme PADI Asia Pacific

PADI Asia Pacific's Registered Training Organisation (RTO) is pleased to announce that the First Aid at Work Programme has now been aligned to the Nationally Recognised Training Unit of Competency **HLTFA301B Apply First Aid** from the Health Training Package (HLT06).

The benefits:

- The First Aid at Work programme can be used to issue a statement of attainment within the vocational training system.
- This recognition further increases the opportunities for instructors to deliver a first aid and CPR programme that meets workplace and vocational training requirements.

To deliver the Nationally Recognised Training Unit of Competency **HLTFA301B Apply First Aid**, follow the steps as outline below:

Step one

You will need to hold the following qualifications:

- Emergency First Response Instructor or Instructor Trainer
- First Aid at Work Instructor or Instructor Trainer
- BSZ40198 Certificate IV in Assessment and Workplace Training or TAA40104 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment
- Clearance to "Work with Children" from relevant authorities in the state you train in.

Step two

Next, you need to apply to PADI Asia Pacific's RTO for authorisation to conduct the training. Please send the following information to **PADI Asia Pacific, P.O. Box 51, NORTH SYDNEY NSW 2059**

- A brief cover letter advising of your wish to apply. Please include your Instructor number and current contact details
- A current and detailed CV including numbers of training sessions run in the last five years, number of students in total, number of students who failed and average monthly training figures
- Current "Working with Children Check". Details of how to get this are available at <http://www.aifs.gov.au/nch/policechecks.html>
- A copy of your BSZ40198 Certificate IV in Assessment and Workplace Training (or TAA40104 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment) signed by a Justice of the Peace

Step three

After we've received and reviewed your application details, you will be contacted by PADI Asia Pacific's RTO for further training and induction procedures which are required prior to you conducting any courses that result in a statement of attainment.
