



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What courses can I teach as an Emergency First Response Instructor?

- A. As an Emergency First Response Instructor, you are qualified to teach adult, child and infant CPR, AED, first aid and emergency oxygen administration.
- Q. How long does the Emergency First Response Instructor course take?
- A. The instructor course takes about 14 hours over a period of two days.
- Q. What are the prerequisites for the instructor course?
- A. To enter the Emergency First Response Instructor course, you must be 18 years old and have completed adult, child and infant CPR and first aid training in the past 24 months.
- Q. What if I am currently an instructor with another certifying organisation?
- A. You are eligible for the Emergency First Response Instructor Crossover course.
- Q. What if I've never had any CPR or First Aid training?
- A. No problem! All you need to do is complete the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR), Secondary Care (first aid) and Care for Children courses first. This takes about a day. These courses can be provided by your Instructor Trainer in conjunction with your Emergency First Response Instructor course.
- Q. Who sets the price for the courses I teach?
- A. You do. We can provide you with general guidelines, but **you** ultimately determine your price.



- Q. I am a current medical professional (EMT, Paramedic, Nurse or Doctor). Do I qualify for the Emergency First Response Instructor Course?
- A. Yes! As a current medical professional you are qualified to enter the Emergency First Response Instructor course.
- Q. How often must I renew my instructor rating?
- A. You must renew every two years.
